- 44 Hart District Council / Hampshire County Council
Hart District Council – There has been concern raised over a proposed housing estate located along Longwater Lane in Finchampstead. Any concerns should be raised with Wokingham Borough Council.
Hampshire County Council – There is likely to be a public consultation on ‘lane leasing’, where HCC will lease out the roads to the utilities companies with the aim of raising much needed revenue as well as encouraging the utilities to work together to complete road works.

2) REF: 24/01272/FUL Glasdon Hill House, Glasdon Hill Road

Installation of ground mounted solar panels.

EPC Consultee Comments: This is a welcome initiative that EPC supports.

3) 23/01436/HOU and 23/02819/LBC Bybridge, The Street

Demolition of existing rear extension and detached garage and erection of a single-story rear extension and part single part one and a half storey link attached side extension, with associated alterations.

EPC Consultee Comments: EPC has no objections provided it is used as a single residential unit.
