- 35 Apologies for Absence
Cllr Neville was absent and sent no apologies.
- 36 Declarations of Interest
Cllr Todd declared an interest in Item 10 ii as he is a neighbour.
- 37 Minutes of the Last Meeting
The minutes of the meeting of Eversley Parish Council held on **Tuesday 6th June 2023** had been previously circulated to all Councillors.

- 38 Co-option
i) Interest had been noted from 1 candidate for one of the 2 vacancies. The candidate was a resident and gave a satisfactory introductory presentation.
ii) J Barnett was proposed and seconded and voted for unanimously.
iii) J Barnett was co-opted onto the Council and signed the Acceptance of Office.
- 39 Public Questions and Comments
Warbrook House - A member of the public advised of the continuous noise infringements by Warbrook House on the residents in Warbrook Lane. Residents are wanting to speak with the owners to resolve the issues.
Longwater Road – The gates outside Dray Stables are covered in nettles, which are also growing over the paths making it difficult for other residents to pass.
County Council – Cllr T Davies provided an update on the Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan for Hart. He urges all residents to read this document and make any comments as deemed fit.
- 40 Burial Ground Extension
The initial Consultancy report was previously circulated to all Councillors.
RESOLVED
 - The Phase 1 Consultancy quote for viability assessment was reviewed.
 - It was agreed to proceed with the specialist consultants and quotation.
 - The budget of £6,000 was agreed to come from the existing council budget for Burial Ground Extension - Consultancy
 - The clerk was approved to make on-stage payments to consultants, with Burial project lead approval.

- Stage 1 - Site Investigation, Walkover Survey and Letter Report = £2,145 to be added to the August payment list
- Stage 2 - Production of a detailed T2 Groundwater Risk Assessment = £2,460 to be approved on successful completion of Stage 1.
- Stage 3 - Stage 3 - EA Liaison = £1,190 to be completed on successful completion of stages 1 and 2.

42 Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan for Hart

The primary cycle route shown along Coopers Hill caused concern due to the narrow, steep sections of the road. It was felt that this is not the best route through Eversley and other routes should be looked at instead. It also caused concern that there were no links to Eversley's SANG land, which should be prime walking and cycling areas within the parish.
